2nd International Conference on Mediterranean Studies 9-12 April 2009, Athens, Greece

The Athens Institute for Education and Research (ATINER) is organizing an International Conference on Mediterranean Studies in Athens, Greece, 9-12 April 2009. (www.atiner.gr/docs/Mediterranean.htm).
