## Call for Papers

Special Issue of *Social Neuroscience* on Developmental Social Neuroscience

A special issue of *Social Neuroscience*, guest-edited by Phil Zelazo and Tomas Paus will feature original empirical articles that integrate developmental, social, and neuroscientific approaches to the study of social functioning. Topics of interest include, for example, emotion, empathy, moral reasoning, prosocial and antisocial behavior, peer influence, cultural influence, and reasoning about social groups.

The special issue is scheduled to appear in the 2010 volume of the journal. Manuscripts should be submitted by September 30, 2009 to the editorial assistant, Duncan Nicholas at [reviews@psypress.co.uk](mailto:reviews@psypress.co.uk)

Manuscripts should be prepared in accordance with the usual guidelines. For details, please see the *Social Neuroscience* Instructions for Authors on the journal homepage:

Authors should include a brief cover letter indicating that they wish their manuscripts to be considered for the special issue on Developmental Social Neuroscience, and explaining why the manuscript is well suited to this issue.

Additionally, *Social Neuroscience* articles have a maximum limit of 9000 words. This 9000 words is to include main text and references, but excludes title, author's contact details, abstract, figures, tables, captions and footnotes.
