The aim of the **LDA** is to promote understanding of learning difficulties through the journal and other publications, as well as professional development activities, and to support the work of teachers and other professionals who provide services to meet the needs of those who have learning difficulties. **LDA** was first established in 1965, and is a not-for-profit organisation governed by a Council of 14 members elected by members of **LDA**.
