Call for Submissions

Since increasing from two to three issues per year in 2007, the ***Journal of Global Ethics*** is now entering its fifth successful year. This expansion of the journal is mirrored in the growth of interest in ethical issues in the many disciplines and professional, practical and policy arenas which constitute global ethics. Our emphasis on global practice and our desire to include policy-makers means we are increasingly succeeding in our aim to impact upon key areas of ethical controversy in our different fields. The forthcoming issues of the journal will continue to realize this ambition, not least in our Special Issues on Social Justice (2009) and Environmental Ethics (2010) which focus attention on key themes in global ethics and all have contributions from major academics and practitioners in the field. To complement these special issues we would encourage submissions on the theory, practice and policy of human rights and international political discourse and law, economic, social and cultural rights and justice, as well as specific case studies of ethics and values in the context of globalization and theorizing about global citizenship and the mechanisms, processes and institutions relevant to global ethics.

Submission Details:

The ***Journal of Global Ethics*** welcomes submissions of manuscripts relating to the topics discussed above.

Papers should be between 6000 and 8000 words, although other lengths and formats will occasionally be accepted and will be considered on a case-by-case basis. All papers will be anonymously reviewed.
