*Acta Linguistica Hafniensia* was founded in 1939 by Viggo Brøndal and Louis Hjelmslev as the voice of the Linguistic Circle of Copenhagen. Its overall aim today is to carry forward the tradition by reflecting the interests of members of the Linguistic Circle while at the same time maintaining an international scope. In particular, the journal aims to function as a Scandinavian forum for functionally and cognitively oriented linguistic research. It therefore invites contributions within the following areas: functional linguistics, cognitive linguistics, pragmatics and sociolinguistics. However, also papers that do not fall within these areas, but are considered of general interest to linguistics or deal with Scandinavian phenomena, will find their way into the journal.

The journal is classified by the European Reference Index for the Humanities (ERIH) as category B journal (“standard, international level publication”, “good reputation among researchers of the field”).

***Acta Linguistica Hafniensia* is the sole linguistic journal in Scandinavia that lays special emphasis on the functional-cognitive and functional-typological aspects of language, and submissions in these areas are particularly welcome.**
