Submit Your Research

NORA welcomes submissions that partake in or reflect Nordic discussions and research interests within the interdisciplinary field of feminist and gender research. Empirical and thematic, theoretical or more conceptual articles are all welcomed, as are open letters, position papers, book reviews and review articles which set several recent books within the context of past debates.

Submitted manuscripts must be written in an academic English of international standard in order to be considered for review (7000-8000 words including notes and references is the preferred length of a scientific article).
