Rigorous scholarship is expected and submissions will be considered in the following categories:

Articles: Synthetic and original research (approximately 3500 words).

Vital Visionaries: Substantial commentary/report guiding future directions of scholars/researchers (approximately 1500 words).

From any age: First person narrative essays informing the broader understanding of the aging process (approximately 1000 words).

Creative works: Original and previously unpublished poems, artwork, musical scores and film reviews. Only black and white reproduction is possible at this point. Narrative explanations must accompany any creative work. Submissions in all areas will be peer reviewed.
