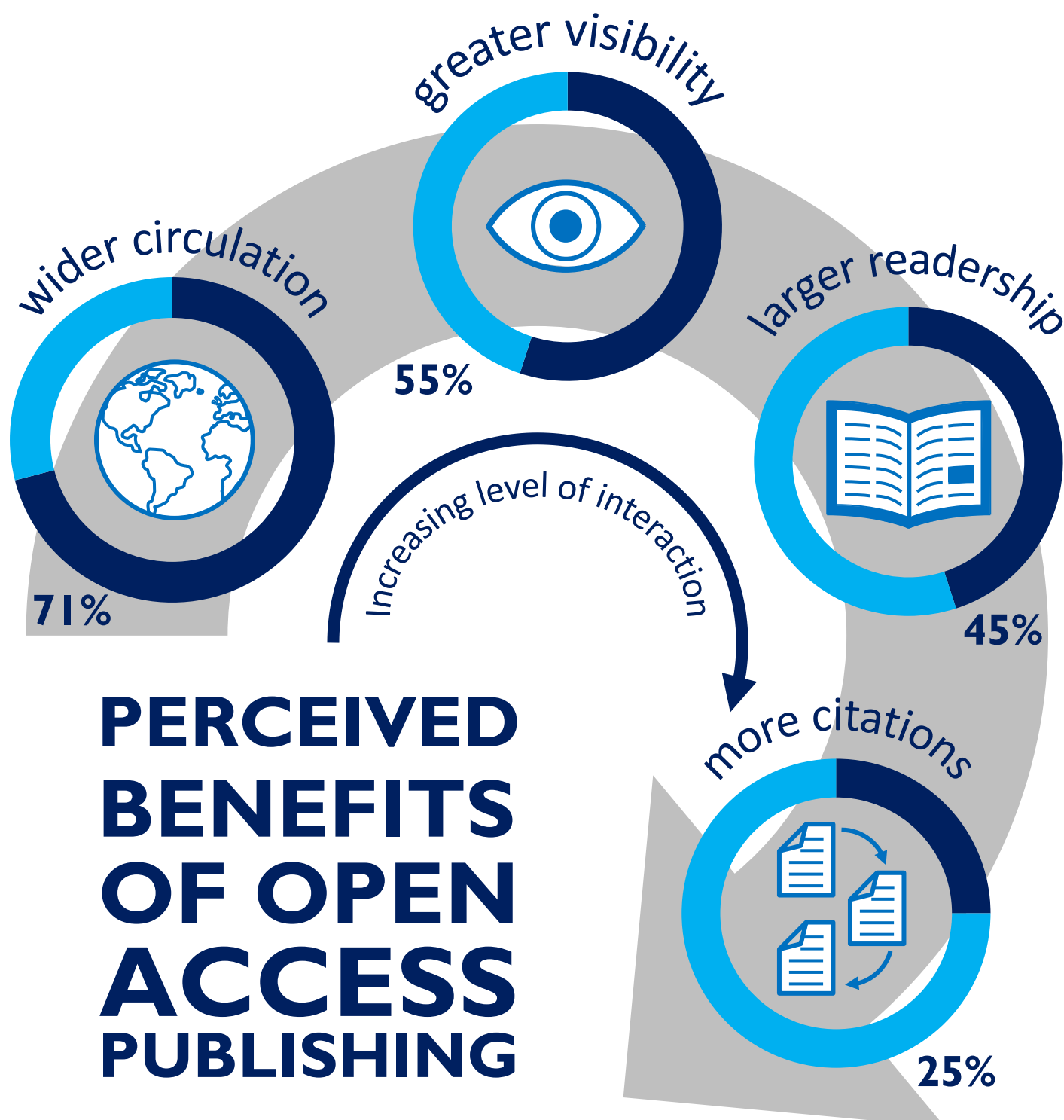

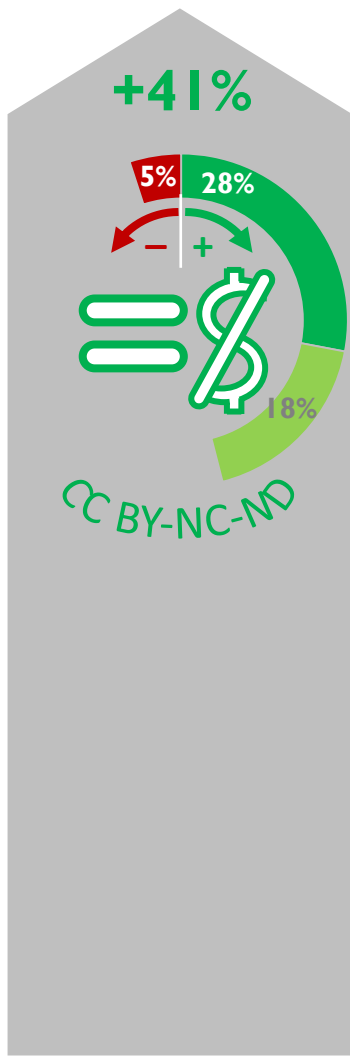

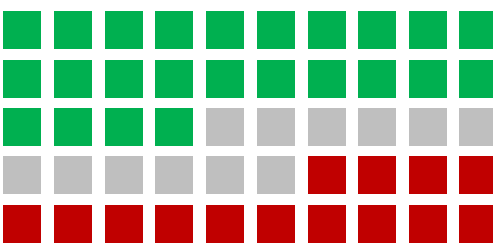

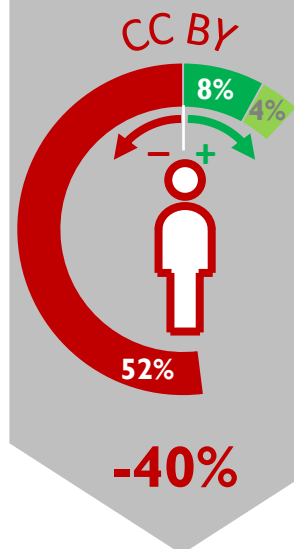
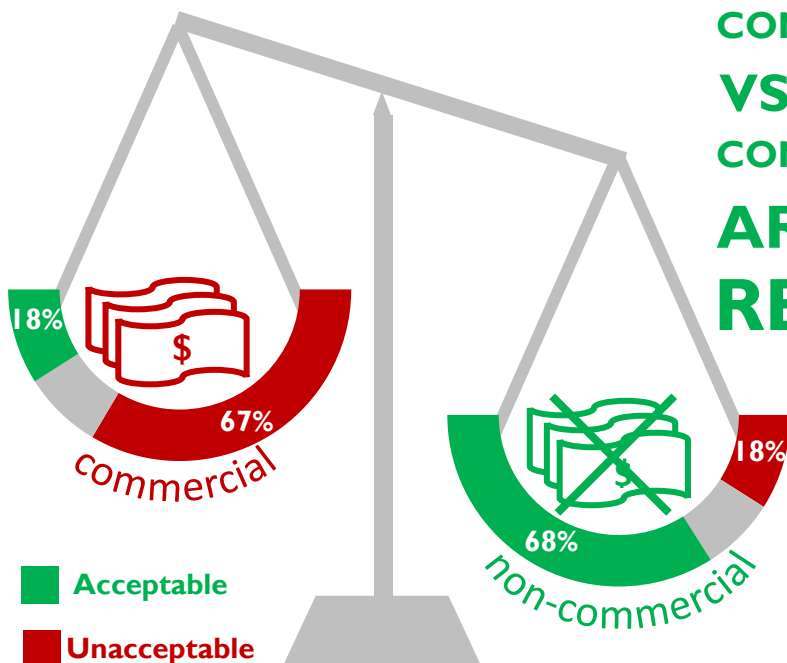

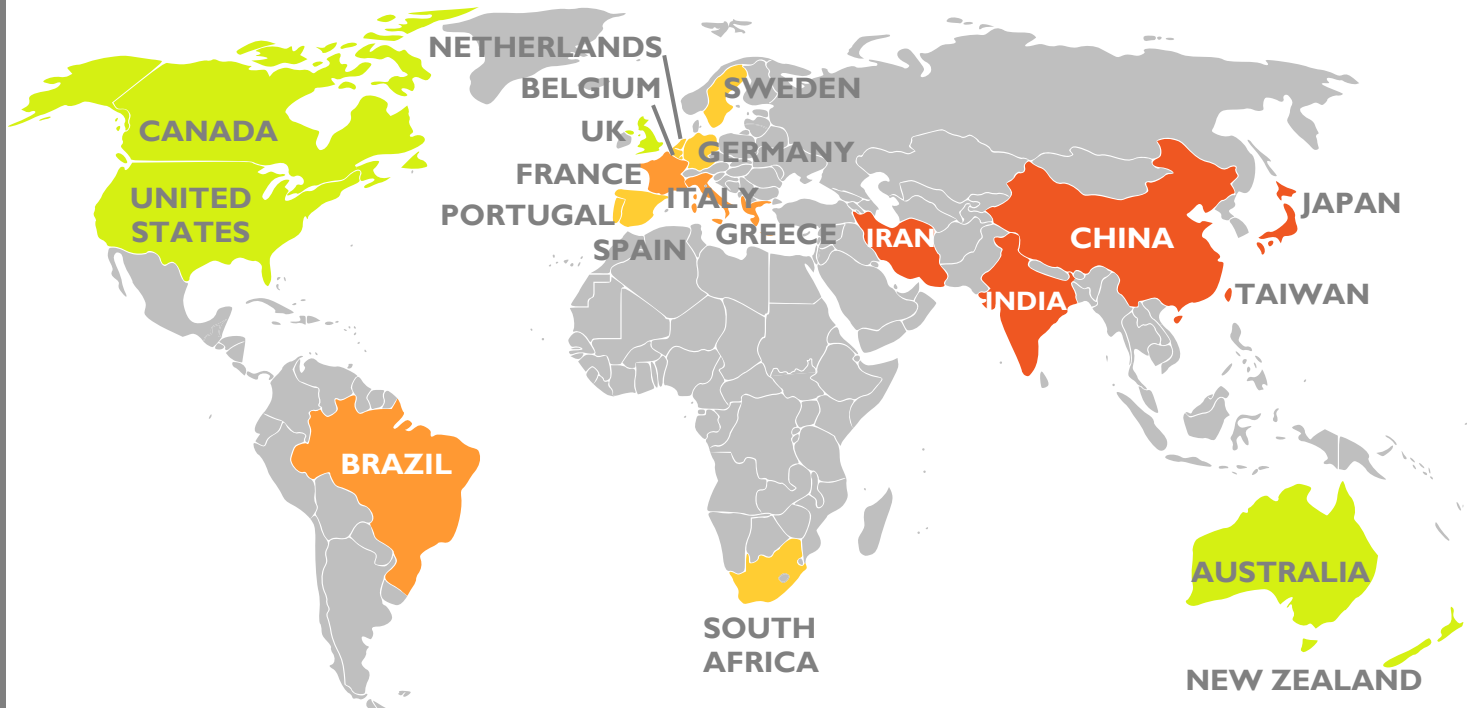


COMMERCIAL VS. NON-COMMERCIAL ARTICLE RE-USE

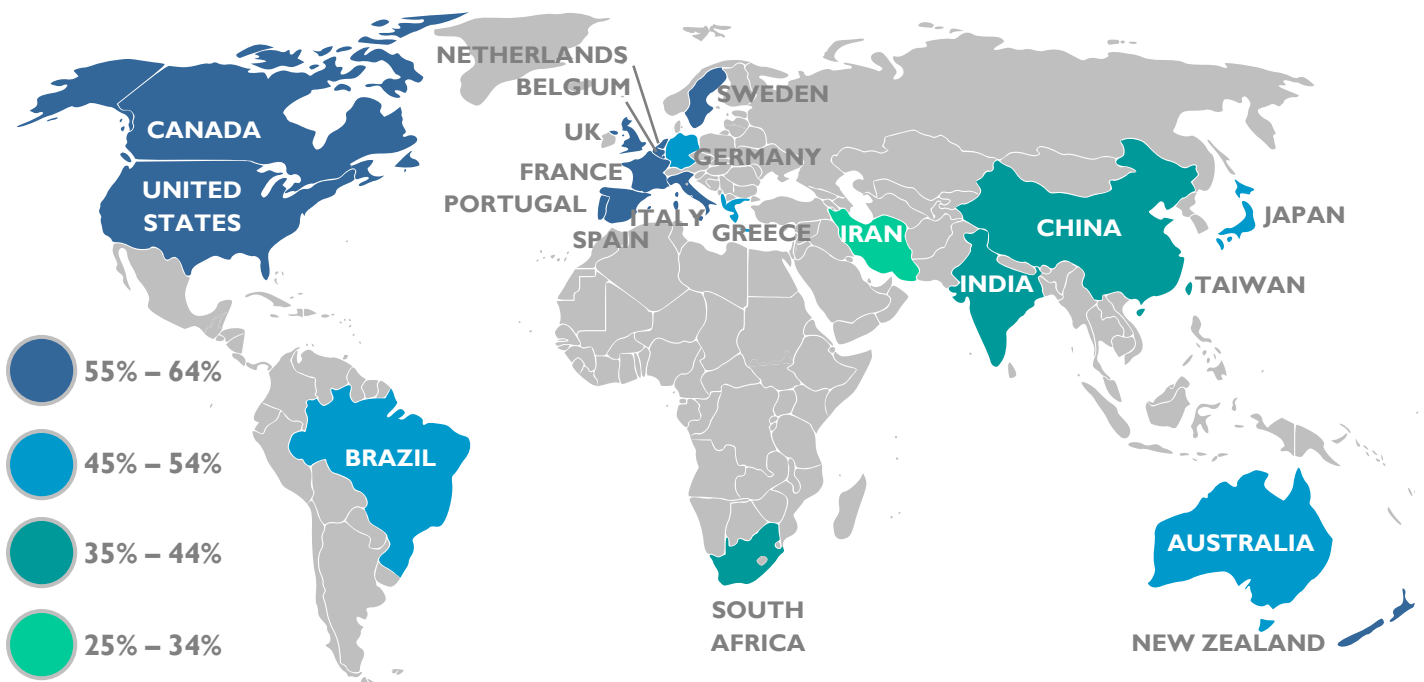

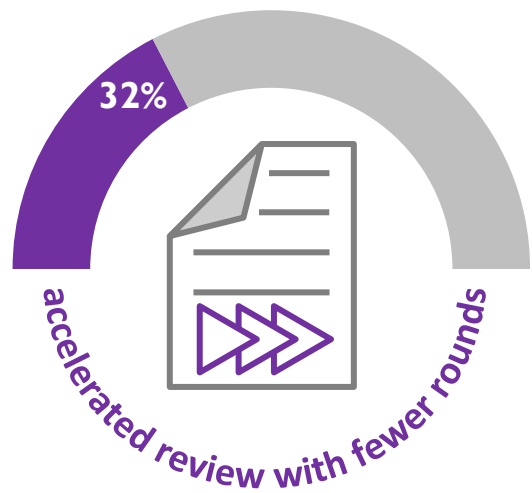
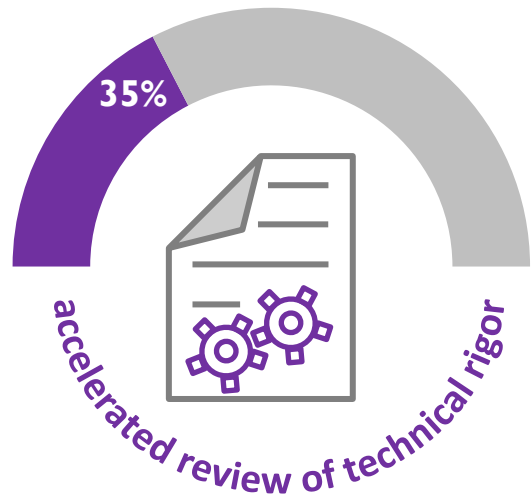

PEER REVIEW PREFERENCES

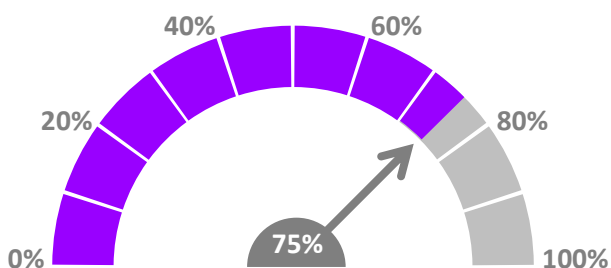
HOW OFTEN AUTHORS FIND EACH OF FOLLOWING TYPES OF PEER REVIEW USEFUL
