

## E. Sridharan

E. Sridharan is the Academic Director of the University of Pennsylvania Institute for the Advanced Study of India (UPIASI), (in New Delhi), from its inception in 1997. He did his B.Sc. (Hons) in Chemistry at St. Stephen's College of Delhi University, and his M.A. and M.Phil. in Political Science at Jawaharlal Nehru University, and earned his Ph.D. in Political Science from the University of Pennsylvania in 1989, and was a Fellow at the Centre for Policy Research, New Delhi, 1989-1997. He has held visiting appointments at the University of California, Berkeley, London School of Economics, Institute for Developing Economies, Tokyo, and Institute of South Asian Studies, National University of Singapore.

He is a political scientist with research interests in the comparative politics and political economy of development, party systems and coalition politics, and international relations theory and conflict resolution in South Asia, in all of which areas he has published and is currently directing projects. He is the author of *The Political Economy of Industrial Promotion: Indian, Brazilian and Korean Electronics in Comparative Perspective 1969-1994* (1996); and has co-edited (with Zoya Hasan and R. Sudarshan), *India's Living Constitution: Ideas, Practices, Controversies* (2002; 2005); co-edited (with Anthony D'Costa), *India in the Global Software Industry: Innovation, Firms Strategies and Development*, (2004); co-edited (with Peter de Souza) *India's Political Parties* (2006); and edited *The India-Pakistan Nuclear Relationship: Theories of Deterrence and International Relations* (2007). He has published over forty journal articles and chapters in edited volumes. He is on the Editorial Advisory Board of *Commonwealth and Comparative Politics*, and is the coordinator in South Asia of the ASIA Fellows Program.
