Journal of Gender Studies aims to promote the work of illustrators engaging with contemporary issues relating to femininity, masculinity, sexuality, gender and queer theory.

Illustrations must, ideally, aim to engage the audience with such issues by amusing them and will be selected on this basis by the editorial team.

The illustrations might be line-drawings or quasi-photographic but must be in black and white. They will be converted to PDF/html for the purposes of publication but can be submitted in a variety of formats (such as jpg, tif, ps or eps) and the artist should state their source application (e.g. Coreldraw/mac, Coreldraw/pc). They should be as near to the final intended size as possible (the journal is printed on B5 size pages, 7x10 inches) and at least 300dpi.
