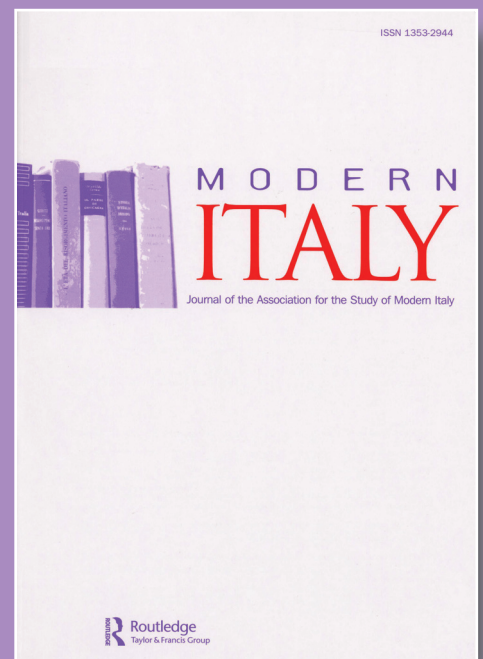


# New to MODERN ITALY FOR 2008

The Christopher Seton-Watson  
Memorial Prize



In memory of the Founder of the Association for the Study of Modern Italy (ASMI) and distinguished historian Christopher Seton-Watson, the Association's journal, *Modern Italy*, is offering a prize of 500 Euros each year for the best article published in the journal during the calendar year. Beginning in 2008, all articles published in the four issues of the journal each year will be read and evaluated by a panel of judges appointed by the Editors of the journal, Martin Bull and Anna Cento Bull. The panel chosen will, whenever possible, consist of one member of the Editorial Committee, one member of the Editorial Advisory Committee and one other academic who is a specialist in one of the general areas covered by the journal. The panel of judges will be established by the Editors in the course of the calendar year.

## Submissions

Submissions and all communications should be made to [modernitaly@salford.ac.uk](mailto:modernitaly@salford.ac.uk), although the Editors welcome informal enquires to their own email addresses: [m.j.bull@salford.ac.uk](mailto:m.j.bull@salford.ac.uk) and [mlsab@bath.ac.uk](mailto:mlsab@bath.ac.uk). Intending contributors should send initial submissions in electronic format by e-mail attachment and are requested to supply a 150 word summary of their article.

Articles should not normally exceed 7,000 words in length, including endnotes, and should contain a 150 word summary of the article. Longer articles may be permitted at the discretion of the Editors. A list of tables, graphs and any other illustrative material should precede the main text (where applicable).

## The Winning Paper

The judging will begin as soon as the fourth issue of the journal is published. The award of the prize will be made at the ASMI Annual General Meeting in the following year.
