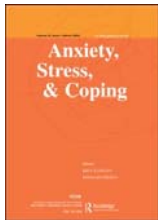

The Stress and Anxiety Research Society (STAR) is a multidisciplinary international organization of researchers who share interests in theoretical, experimental, and applied aspects of anxiety, stress and coping.



The Society publishes the journal Anxiety, Stress & Coping (ISSN 1061-5806). The journal scored a 2010 JCR Impact Factor: 1.825 (Q1 Psychology multidisc.). Editors-in-chief are Dr. Aleksandra Luszczynska and Dr. Nazanin Derakhshan.

The STAR International Conferences

The Annual STAR international conference is one of the most prestigious world conferences focusing on research into stress, anxiety, and related phenomena. The conference is multidisciplinary, spanning fields related to psychology and health sciences.

The first STAR conference was held in Leiden, Netherlands, in 1980. Since that landmark, the STAR conference has visited some of the world's most beautiful cities and countries, as well as some of its most prestigious universities.
