It is preferred that Editorial candidates have a strong background in Elder Abuse research. Accomplished research experiences in Family Violence, Criminal Justice, Gerontology, or Trauma may be considered. The editorship includes an honorarium. Applicants will be reviewed by a special panel of the **National Committee for the Prevention of Elder Abuse (NCPEA)**, with selection of an Editor-in-Chief expected by December 15, 2011. The term of the named Editor-in-Chief will begin **January 1, 2012**.
