## Meetings

Divisions have been established in each State and Territory and there are Branches in Hunter Valley and Broken Hill. Meetings are arranged by each Division. Other meetings, field trips and symposia are arranged from time to time by Divisions, Branches and Specialist Groups. The Australian Geological Convention is held biennially. The next convention is in Melbourne on 2-7<sup>th</sup> July 2006.

## Publications

**Australian Journal of Earth Sciences** (Scientific Journal, 6 issues pa), **Alcheringa** (Palaeontology Journal, 2 issues pa), **The Australian Geologist** (TAG, 4 issues pa). Abstracts of Conventions, Divisional and Specialist Group books and field guides. Members have the option of choosing either the *Australian Journal of Earth Sciences* or *Alcheringa* as their "membership journal". AJES is available as either hard copy or on-line, or both. All Members receive TAG.

## Membership

Members will normally be a graduate of a university or other tertiary institution with a major in earth sciences, or a graduate actively engaged in work related to the earth sciences. In special circumstances the Executive Committee may approve for Membership:

- (a) people who have been employed in some technical aspect of earth science experience for a period of at least five years or;
- (b) people who have undertaken and published the results of research in the earth sciences.

## Associate Membership

There shall be no specific qualifications required of Associate Members, but every candidate for election must be at least 18 years old, and should produce evidence of a genuine interest in the earth sciences. A school or other non-commercial group may become an Associate Member. People who are eligible for Membership cannot be Associate Members, unless normally a resident outside Australia.

## Joint Membership

A candidate for election as a Joint Member shall fulfil all the requirements of a Member with the stipulation that they be the recognised partner of an existing Member. Joint Members shall retain all privileges other than the right to receive the journal.

## Retired Member

A Member of the Society of at least ten (10) years standing who has retired from professional practice is eligible to apply for Retired Membership. Retired Members retain all privileges and have the option of membership with or without the journal.

## Student Membership

To be eligible for student membership a person must be an enrolled student (full-time or part-time) attending a tertiary educational institution or a secondary school student, studying earth sciences. Applicants must provide certification from the Head of their academic department.

## Graduate Membership

Graduate membership is for current student members who have recently graduated. This membership is valid for the first 2 years after qualifying and includes AJES via internet.
