



Important: Changes to Taylor & Francis journal content on IngentaConnect

Dear Customer,

From January 2012, Taylor & Francis Group and Publishing Technology are changing the way in which users can access Taylor & Francis Group's journal content via the [ingentaconnect](#) platform. These changes may affect your library users.

Currently users are able to access content on a pay-per-view basis, and this option will remain in place after January 2012.

Institutional subscribers are also currently able to register their authentication details with ingentaconnect to allow library users to read subscribed Taylor & Francis Group content. This option will be withdrawn from January 2012, with users being advised to access their Taylor & Francis Group holdings via [Taylor & Francis Online](#).
