### **Expanded Routledge Psychoanalysis Coverage in PEP**

We are pleased to announce that Psychoanalytic Electronic Publishing (PEP) will now cover three additional Routledge journals – *Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy*, *Journal of Child Psychotherapy*, *Journal of Infant, Child and Adolescent Psychotherapy* – taking the total number of Routledge titles in the database to eight.\*

As part of our new agreement, PEP has set up a new Author Royalty Fund to benefit contributors, and Editors of Routledge Journals in PEP will be able to distribute this to authors of highly downloaded articles.

Rohays Perry, Head of the Behavioral Sciences at Routledge, has referred to the strengthened partnership as “truly beneficial for all concerned and indeed for psychoanalysis as a long-established and growing field”.

Nadine A. Levinson, D.D.S, Co-Managing Director of Psychoanalytic Electronic Publishing Inc, has expressed PEP's delight about the expanded collaboration with Routledge. She also added that in September 2010 PEP will be introducing an Enhanced Search Engine with three new elements: citation capacity; statistics of most read PEP articles; and a powerful glossary of psychoanalytic terms integrated from four key psychoanalytic glossaries, semantically enriching all PEP articles, and providing all the relevant information from multiple sources in a single view.
