**Another year of outstanding growth by Taylor & Francis Group Journals in the *Web of Science*® and 2008 *Journal Citation Reports*®**

Oxford, UK, 17<sup>th</sup> August, 2009 –Taylor & Francis, Routledge, and Psychology Press have increased the number of titles indexed in Thomson Reuters' *Web of Science*® by more than 25% in the last year. Taylor & Francis Group now publishes 615 titles listed in *Web of Science*: 455 titles ranked with impact factors in the 2008 *Journal Citation Reports*® (JCRs), 77 titles due for listing in forthcoming editions and awaiting impact factors, plus 105 titles listed overall in the 2008 *Arts & Humanities Citation Index*®. (Note that some titles are listed in more than one Index.)

The number of JCR listed journals published by T&F imprints is more than 9% higher than in the 2007 release. T&F has more journals than any other Publisher in 10 categories, including Area Studies, Cybernetics, Education & Educational Research, Psychology (Science edition), Biomedical Social Sciences, Ethnic Studies, International Relations, and Women's Studies.

The impressive growth of citations to Taylor & Francis Group journals is reflected in a 16% increase in total citations to journals listed in both the 2007 and 2008 JCRs (up from an 11% rise last year), compared to an average 13% growth in citations across all titles in the JCRs.

Taylor & Francis publishes the top ranked title in 15 categories, including Urban Studies, Transport Science & Technology, Environmental Sciences, Oceanography, Food Science & Technology, Cybernetics, Ethnic Studies, Ethics, Public Administration, and History of Social Science. *American Journal of Bioethics* remains top in five different categories.

More than 160 Taylor & Francis Group journals increased their Impact Factor by 25% or higher, and 17 Taylor & Francis Group journals gained an Impact Factor for the first time. Dr David Green, Global Journals Publishing Director comments: "It is very pleasing to see that our innovative partnership programme with Editors and Societies to enhance usage, citations and impact is bearing such fruit. This is testimony to excellence displayed by all parties – Editors, Authors and Taylor & Francis publishing teams around the globe."
