

Taylor & Francis joins AIP's UniPHY social network

Information from 32 Taylor & Francis Physical Science journals can now be accessed via UniPHY with coverage dating back as early as 1910!

Taylor & Francis has partnered with the American Institute of Physics (AIP) to offer academics access to UniPHY (www.aipuniphy.org). UniPHY is AIP's scientific social and professional networking site designed to enhance and accelerate collaboration amongst physical science researchers. It offers the chance for academics to network with colleagues and co-authors, identify expert researchers, locate peers and colleagues, and access data from top journals in the field.

Taylor & Francis has submitted data from 32 journals which dates from 1910 to the present day. Physicists will be able to access abstracts and author information and expand their network with this additional data, helping them to advance their research and raise their profiles within their community.

With UniPHY's "six-degrees"-style mapping, authors can:

- Network with colleagues and co-authors – over 300,000 researcher profiles
- Follow a web of connections showing each co-author with whom colleagues have worked
- Identify expert researchers
- Learn where peers and colleagues are located

Other features include discussion groups, recommend an article, congratulate an author, job postings and upcoming industry events.

If an author has published at least three physics articles in Taylor & Francis publications their research profile may already have been created in UniPHY. If not, a simple sign-up allows authors to create a profile by adding articles individually.

To get on board colleagues need to register at UniPHY.org – as easy as any social networking site.
