

Advice to authors on preparing references

References are based on standard Chicago Author-Date style (<u>http://www.tandf.co.uk/journals/authors/style/reference/tf_ChicagoAD.pdf</u>) with the following additional style points.

The author's full name (John Smith 2014) should be used at the *first* mention of a citation in the text; only the surname is used thereafter (Smith 2014).

For up to 3 authors mention all names in the text citation; for 4 or more authors use all names at the first mention then first author et al. thereafter.

If more than 7 authors use first 7 then et al. in text. List all names up to 10 authors in reference list; if more list first 7 then et al.

For multiple same-year references, use a, b etc.

Use 'forthcoming' rather than 'in press'.
